3. Poems must be typed or neatly hand printed in English on one side of 8 ½ by 11 paper.
4. Send original and ONE COPY with no identification on original. Name, address, telephone number, category and grade level in upper left-hand corner of paper.
5. Entries improperly submitted may be disqualified.
6. Winners will be announced and winning poems will be read at the Riley Festival Poetry Contest held during the Festival.
7. All submissions will be destroyed, copyright remains with the author. Publishing first rights granted to media.
8. DEADLINE: SEPTEMBER 5, 2008
9. In the pursuit of poetic excellence, written contest winners are requested to read their poems at the Poetry Awards presentation on Friday evening, October 3rd, 2008, at 7:00 P.M. at 1st Presbyterian Church-116 W. South St.
