## **GENERAL RULES:**

1. This contest is open to anyone, male or female, any age, and any county.
2. Exhibits shall have been made, completed or prepared by exhibitor within the past year and **never before exhibited at Riley Festival.**
3. No entry fee will be charged.
4. Exhibits will be judged in two categories:  
JUNIOR: 16 and under and SENIOR: 17 and above.
5. **ALL ENTRIES IN ALL CATEGORIES ARE DUE WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2008 FROM 12 P.M. TO 7 P.M.**
6. **THE SHOW WILL CLOSE ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 5, AT 4:00 P.M. EXHIBITS WILL BE RELEASED FROM 4:30 PM. – 5:30 PM. NO EARLY RELEASES!**
7. Each entry will be awarded a ribbon signifying a blue, red or white placing. Sweepstakes will be awarded in each category with an asterisk (\*).
8. The Hancock County Farm Bureau, Hancock County Extension Homemakers, Sam's Club and Riley Festival will use all diligence to assure the safety of articles after arrival and during the festival. They will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
9. We reserve the right to combine or separate sections, according to the number of entries received.
10. All entries for Food Preservation should be labeled as to the content and date preserved.
11. All entries in all food sections must include the recipe.
12. Questions concerning rules and entries should be directed to the Co-Directors listed.
13. **Categories will be added or deleted at the judges' discretion.**

Must be in a standard canning jar and have two piece lid. **ALL** jellies, jams, relish and pickles will be judged on **APPEARANCE, SEAL, AND TASTE**. These must be processed according to USDA Recommendations- **NO paraffin allowed. Recipe must include processing procedure.**

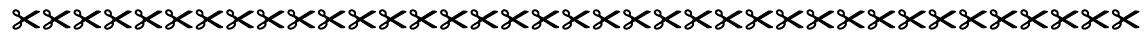
