READ ALL RULES THOROUGHLY BEFORE ENTERING PHOTOS

1. This is primarily an amateur photography contest. The Professional division is open to those who sell or have sold their photographs. Professional entries will be judged separately from amateur entries.
2. All photographs entered must be the work of the exhibitor.
3. Entry form must be completely filled out and submitted with photo entries.
4. Photos previously entered in the Riley Festival Photography Contest will not be accepted.
5. **ENTRY FEES** -- Fees payable at time of entry. Adults \$3.00 1-4 entries. Children and Intermediate \$1.00 1-4 entries. Hollenbaugh Memorial Award entry is in addition to division entries with no extra fee.
6. **MOUNTING** -- Overall presentation is taken into consideration during judging. Photographs must be permanently mounted on mat board or stiff backing material. Corrugated cardboard or thin poster board is not acceptable. Photos can have front matting but **no framed photos will be accepted**. Photos are not required to have hangers on the back. Computer printed images must be printed on photo quality paper. No plain paper images will be accepted.
7. **SIZE OF PHOTOGRAPHS** – Adult, Professional and Intermediate divisions minimum size 8”x 10”. Minimum size for Children - snapshots 4”x 6”.
8. **HOLLENBAUGH MEMORIAL ENTRY** -- The theme for the Hollenbaugh Award is “FUN ‘N GAMES.” This category is for Children and Intermediates and is limited to one entry per student. The exhibitor must attend a Hancock County school. The winner receives a gift certificate or cash prize and their school receives a grant for youth photography education. This entry has no entry fee and is in addition to the division limit of four entries.
9. **COMPUTER ENHANCED/CREATIVE/EXPERIMENTAL IMAGE CLASS** – This class is for photos that have been manipulated. All photographic images appearing in the photo must be the work of the photographer entering the image and must have ALL original processed images (size 4x6) attached to the back of the photo. Any photographs with the multi-image scans, ripped, shredded, cut or changes/manipulations made to the photo other than B&W or Sepia toned prints will be placed into this category and must meet all the rules stated above.
10. **IDENTIFICATION** – Name, address, phone number, division, type and category must be on the back of the photo entries. Children and Intermediate entries must include age and school. Location of print is encouraged.
11. **PHOTO DROP-OFF**- - Entries must be delivered to Riley Park Shelter House, Wednesday, Oct. 6, between 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Please deliver photos as early as possible. **NO LATE ENTRIES.**
12. **RELEASE TIME** -- Sunday, October 10, from 4:00-6:00 p.m. **NO early releases.** Photographs not picked up will be kept for 30 days in the Riley Festival Office (462-2141). Photos will be discarded after 30 days. All entries are exhibited at your own risk. All possible care will be taken to safeguard the exhibits, but no responsibility will be assumed by the Riley Festival for any loss or damage in transit or while in our possession.
13. **THE RILEY FESTIVAL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT PRINTS THEY DEEM TO BE IN POOR TASTE, OR TO REMOVE AFTER HUNG, IF PUBLIC COMPLAINTS ARISE.**
